City of Sebastopol Bike Rack Program

November 1, 2009

The City of Sebastopol has acquired grant funding from the Bay Area Air Quality Control District (BAAQMD) for a program to encourage local businesses to install bike racks on private properties in Sebastopol, to provide convenient, safe parking for customers and encourage the use of bicycles as an alternative mode of transportation, to reduce vehicle emissions.

Under this program City staff will meet with interested property and business owners to determine the number of bicycles to be accommodated at your place of business, and a suitable location for installation of bike racks. Property owners will be asked to sign an agreement with the City acknowledging that once installed, the racks become your property and responsibility. The City will then purchase and install the racks at no cost to businesses or property owners. Only businesses located within the City of Sebastopol are eligible to apply.
